Example Project #1:

Nazarene Compassionate Ministry Center



- **Description:** A Nazarene Compassionate Ministry Center in Guatemala is in urgent need of improvements to better serve its community, requiring a new bathroom and completion of the current building. Currently serving 56 children, the center needs a safe and habitable space where they can learn, be cared for, and receive daily nourishment. Completing these essential upgrades will provide a cleaner and comfortable environment for both children and staff.
- **Team Size:** Up to 16 People

Example Project #2:

Caserio El Tucan



- **Description:** This local church has faithfully constructed the walls of their new building and is now requesting partnership to install a roof, concrete floor, and electrical system so the church can begin using the space for worship and ministry. These improvements will provide a safe and functional space where the congregation can gather for worship, discipleship, and community outreach.
- **Team Size:** Up to 16 People

Example Project #3:

Portable Chapel



➤ **Portable Chapels:** Nazarene Missions Teams in Guatemala install portable chapels to provide a safe, usable facility where churches are planted. Once the church develops the resources necessary to build a church, the portable chapel is disassembled and relocated to a new church plant site. Local leaders hope that this portable chapel concept will revolutionize church planting for the Church of the Nazarene.

➤ **Team Size:** Up to 16 People

Máxima Misión: La Puerta Abierta

Máxima Misiones an initiative in the region for Nazarene Missions Teams to partner with a group of young people from Guatemala that believes in missions and wants to do their part to share God's love in their own country. A Máxima Misión team provides American teams the opportunity to work on the construction project and participate in evangelism activities.

- **Serving with Nazarene Missions Teams in Guatemala**
- In 2009, while leading a Work and Witness trip to Guatemala, Matt and Fay felt God tugging at their hearts to increase their involvement in missions. 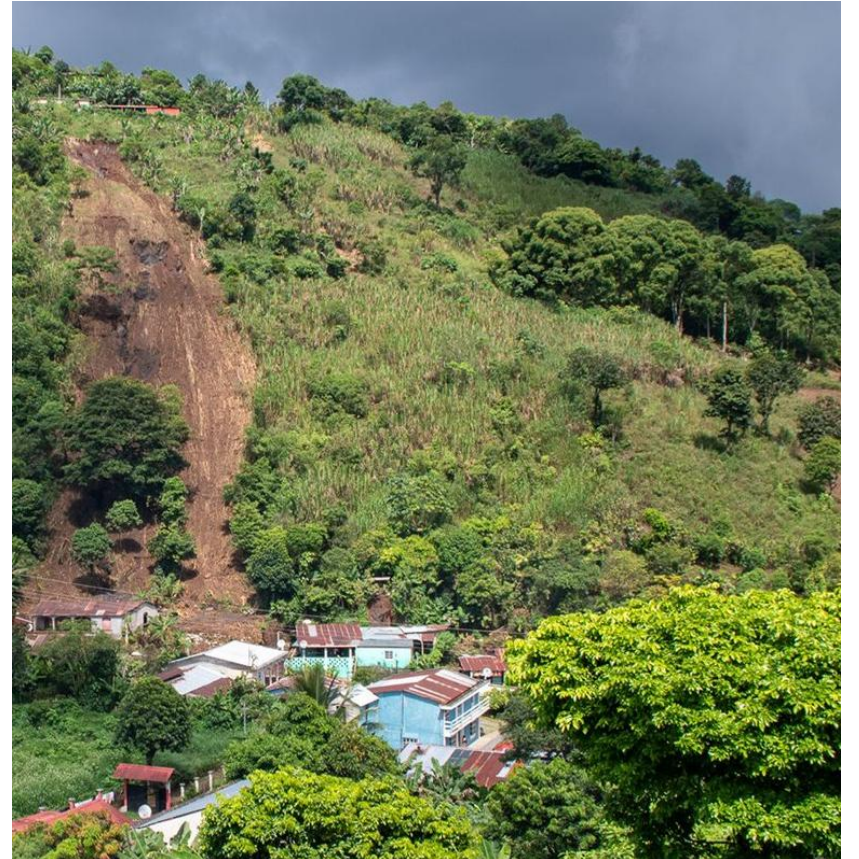
Roger and Demaris Kellogg

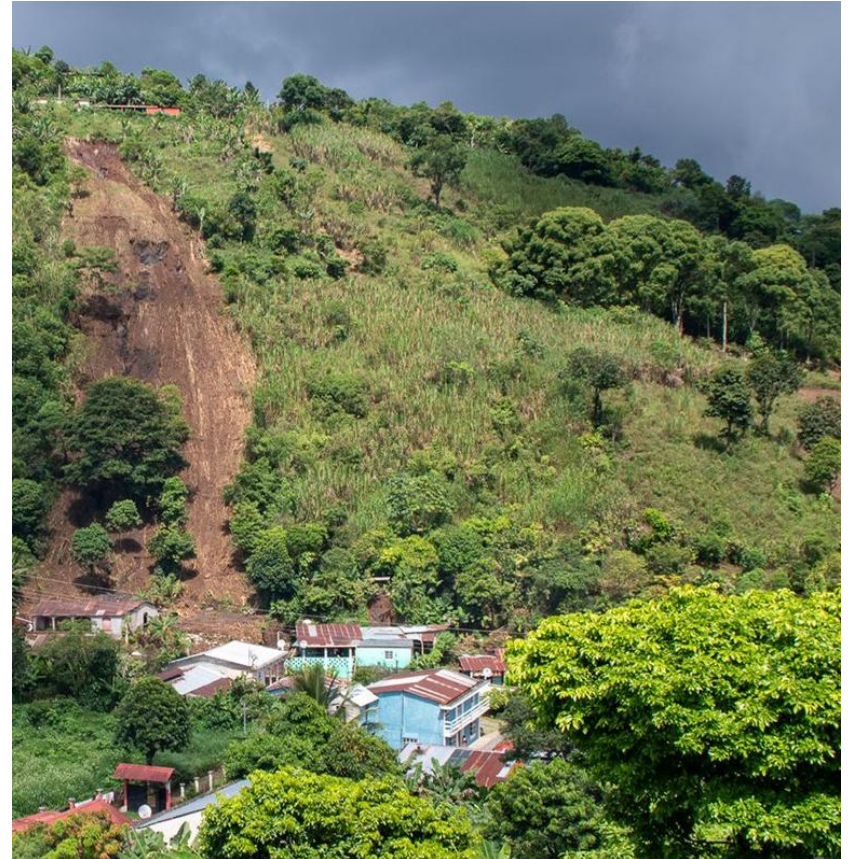
Planning Timeline

- **April 2026:** Initial Information to Local NMI Presidents
- **May 1, 2026:** Registration Opens
- **September 2026:** Informational Presentation for Potential Participants
- **October 2026:** Recruitment Push to Local NMI Presidents
- **December 31, 2026:** Registration Closes
- **January through July:** Monthly Zoom Meetings to Provide Information and Conduct Team Building



Cost

- \$90 per day x 8 days = \$720
- Flight = \$800
- Other Fees and Costs (Luggage) = \$80
